Mass and Lunch with Bishop Zubik

Bishop David Zubik will celebrate Mass at St. Paul's Cathedral on Sunday, April 19, 2009 at 10:00 a.m. Father Kevin Poecking, Spiritual Advisor for the Pittsburgh Chapter of the Christ Child Society, will be a concelebrant. The Mass is in recognition of the Society's continued support to the newborn and disadvantaged children of Pittsburgh and the metropolitan area. In the past year, the Society has donated over 700 new winter coats, hats and gloves to needy children. Throughout the past year, the Christ Child Society has also assembled and distributed over 200 newborn layettes to area hospitals and Catholic Charities. In addition, the Society continues to work with boys at Holy Family Institute, as well as offering support to the Roselia Center.

There will be a luncheon immediately following Mass at the Pittsburgh Athletic Association. Bishop Zubik will be the guest speaker. Tickets for the luncheon are \$30 per person. ANNUAL CHRIST CHILD RETREAT

On Wednesday, March 18, 2009, our spiritual advisor, Father Kevin Poecking led our annual retreat at the Kearns Spirituality Center. Father began with the Rosary, and then gave seven short meditations on the Seven Last Words of Christ. These meditations grew out of his research in a book written by Adrienne von Spyer entitled The Cross, Word and Sacrament. In this text, Ms. von Spyer likened each of the Seven Last Words to one of the Sacraments. We were directed to the humanity of Jesus, as He suffered on the Cross, and also to the gifts of the Sacraments left to His Church. Each of us who were able to attend the retreat were enriched and inspired by Father's meditations. Following lunch, Father led our group in the Stations of the Cross, and the day was concluded with Mass in the beautiful chapel of the Center. Over the years, we have been fortunate to have had some very inspirational, thoughtful and challenging retreat leaders. This year was no exception. Each of us left with much to ponder, and are quite enriched with the ideas Father presented.


