The weekend began with a seminar on Friday afternoon relating to accounting and banking practices. Brian Giganti, CPA, answered questions about chapter accounting and tax practices that we should have in place and be using. After dinner on Friday, we were introduced to Susan Ellis, who was leading the program on Saturday about volunteerism. Ms. Ellis was quite entertaining and had us participating in thought provoking questions, "Start Your Engines: Perspectives on Our Legacy".

Ms. Ellis of Energize, Inc. held a dynamic workshop on Saturday which centered on her theme of "Is it still your Grandmother's Volunteering"? Louise Merrick Hamilton was the younger sister of our foundress, Mary Virginia Merrick. The Chapel Sanctuary was a private prayer chapel of the Hamilton family. Mary Virginia Merrick was known to reside briefly at the estate, known as "Stone Ridge" and worshiped in the chapel. The former ballroom is now part of the Chapel and we were blessed to have Rev. Msgr. Thomas M. Duffy as our celebrant. This was a wonderful Conference and sent us back with ideas and enthusiasm to share!

ANGELS' CLOSET


