For all our members who faithfully continue to support our mission through donations, fundraising and volunteer "hands -on " time— we thought it nice to share these notes and let you know that you really do make a difference!

FROM ONE AGENCY......Please thank the Christ Child Society for the beautiful baby layettes. They are so lovely and so nice to be able to pass them on.

-One layette was given to a teenager at Perry High School. Unbelievable she didn't know she was pregnant and was rushed from school to the hospital in labor.
- Another went to a single Mom with two other children and no help from the father.
- Another layette went to a Mom who has four older children and had not planned to have another.One went to a rape victim. She is 15 years old and getting therapy.
- Another layette was given to Jamie. It is her sixth child and she had nothing for the baby. Please pray for her. She has no money and no parenting skills. They all live in an empty house without hot water. Someone gave her money for the gas bill and she paid her cable bill instead. They also have five cats in the house.
-Last week a woman and her boyfriend were coming to Pittsburgh from Virginia. She had no prenatal care and delivered triplets. The father left when he realized they had three babies. Some people got her into housing. I was delighted to be able to give her the last three layettes.

The Christ Child Society has been such a blessing for these Mothers.

Your NCCS Board had its Spring Board Meeting February 28, March 1 2014 in Dearborn Michigan. Under discussion was the Biennial Convention 2014 to be held in Phoenix Arizona, September 18 – 20, 2014. Careful planning is going into mini seminars, workshops, etc. that will speak to the needs of the Chapters. All members of Christ Child are eligible to attend, however only 2 voting delegates are permitted per Chapter. Since our Chapter has always had a policy of paying for our 2 voting delegates to attend the Convention and Conference, we are assured of a Pittsburgh presence in Phoenix. It is true that the more members of a Chapter that attend, the more the Chapter will glean from the seminars and networking that will be part of the meeting. Let's think about having more than 2 members from Pittsburgh attend, perhaps with spouses or a friend, and then extend the 'working weekend' a few days!!! Sedona is a beautiful city north of Phoenix, of course the Grand Canyon is north of Sedona, and in Phoenix itself there are many cultural, and sports opportunities available.
