A delivery of 30 bags was made on April 28 to the "VOICe, Victim Outreach Intervention Center" who have a shelter for women and children in the Cranberry Township area. Although it sits in a serene and beautiful setting, it is heart wrenching to think of the women and children housed there in order to escape abuse.
