

OUR NEW HOME...... ALL SAINTS PARISH, ETNA

Early in the fall of 2015, Christ Child received news that we would have to move from our home in the former St. Augustine High School. The Capuchin Friars have plans for a new building on the site. A search for a new home was begun. The hope was that we could find something that would be accessible to our clients (on a bus route, or easy to find via other transportation) and our members alike (first floor, storage space, adequate parking and meeting space). Lead by Mary Jo Kelly, many 'feelers' were put out looking for a space that fit our needs. The search included letters to pastors, realtors, asking friends and family. The Diocese Property Planning office was contacted and gave several suggestions. One of those sites suggested was to look into the former All Saints Parish School building in Etna.

Fr. Jim Gretz, Administrator of All Saints, agreed to show us space in the building. Mary Jo Kelly, Ellen O'Brien, and Fred O'Brien visited the building, the room available, and another room that can be used for meetings. With no hesitation, both Mary Jo and Ellen felt this space was perfect for Christ Child, and agreed to go forward with the rental process. It met our needs, including being on the first floor, plenty of parking, on a bus line, adequate storage space, and an affordable rent. The parish council and Fr. Jim agreed to the rental, the Diocese agreed, and papers were signed by all parties. We had our new home!!

Wednesday March 2, 2016 was moving day! Molly Kelley spent many hours researching movers, and engaged the most economical firm. She and Bob Kelley met the movers at the former site and supervised the move to All Saints. Many of the CCS Board members, and other members met at the site, and supervised the move in process. With many helping, things were put away and Christ Child was on its way to serving needy children. There is still work to be done to get the room ready for layette packing and Angel's Closet this coming fall. On Thursday March 17, 2016, the first meeting of Christ Child was held in the new space, and the rest of the membership got their first view of the new space.

A heartfelt thank you to all who worked to find this new space, organize and help pack for the move, and with the move in process. The office staff at All Saints has been very welcoming and helpful. Thank you Fr. Jim Gretz, along with the office staff Gerry Ferraro and Shirley Schmict, our friends at All Saints. We hope for many many years of mission collaboration at All Saints.


