These children have breakfast and lunch at school during the week but might not have enough food on the weekends. Food is sent home with each participating child every Friday. Each bag includes enough food for two breakfasts, two lunches, and two snacks. Within the offerings, there will be two fruits/vegetables and two proteins. (A one-day example is a breakfast bar, individual macaroni & cheese, applesauce, and pretzels.) Our Christ Child members can help with this project by attending any packings which take place at Fox Chapel Presbyterian Church. Packings are on Mondays at 11:30 am \*\*unless otherwise noted.
