On Mondays and Thursdays each week, the **Youth Empowerment Program** has been working hard packing food bags for the children in Sharpsburg. The program is called "GRAB and GO MEALS" and is funded with the grants "NO KID HUNGRY" and NIAGARA CARE".

Each Monday and Thursday about 45 children are provided with 3 breakfasts, 3 lunches, 3 juices and 6 milks. On Thursday they also receive a "weekend food bag".

The kitchen at *All of Us Care* is being remodeled to include a commercial stove and oven that will enable the staff to prepare over 100 lunches for children in Sharpsburg, Millvale and Etna this summer.

The summer camp this year will be on line because of COVID-19.

The **Youth Empowerment Program** is doing a fantastic job with the help of their Program Director, Tarcia Rebeitz and staff.
