ANGELS' CLOSET - 2022 FINAL REPORT

Our distribution for 2022 (seven week period) was 159 coats, along with hats and gloves. We also gave out 140 books to the children to take home. In addition many of the clients read books while waiting for try -ons.

Next year we may go to Saturdays *only* since that seems to be when the largest distributions occurred.
