Notes ~ General Christ Child Society Meeting, Saturday September 20, 2025

CCS members were briefed on how meetings can only be held on Saturdays in the CCS room, according to the new rules of the building. It was discussed that CCS general meetings will be there on Saturdays or at Eat'n Park on Banksville Road in their room on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday. *Please be vigilant as to where the meeting is being held when attending.*

MARLENE MACDONALD, Treasurer, disseminated the Treasurer's report. There was a discrepancy, and it is believed that the profit for the Red Wagon is \$9,343.98 instead of \$14,343.98. She will investigate and verify this figure. Marlene would like to be replaced as Treasurer.

MOLLY KELLEY, Chair of Angels' Closet, expressed concern for parking when children pick out coats. After 12: 00 it is likely more parking will be available. There will be two options. Coats can be picked up by agency social workers or children can pick them out. After the meeting, two dates were given for the Angels' Closet committee. The dates are Saturday, October 25, 2025, (10 AM to 3 PM) and Saturday, November 1, 2025, (also 10 AM to 3 PM).

JUDY KERN was unable to attend but is starting the newsletter on September 25th and needs dates and information to include in the newsletter from CCS members.

CHARLOTTE COLLINS, Layette Chair, reported 60 layettes were packed in July and a future packing will be done later in the year.

PATTI SMITH, Membership Chair, was not in attendance but wanted to inform members that a list of members was compiled and sent out to members.

MARIA KITAY, Publicity Chair, reported that she had contact with someone at LaRoche College who can help with publicity digitally and work on graphics. She inquired if our CCS pamphlets can be added to church bulletins or placed in churches. She will investigate as to which churches will give permission, and other members can help by seeking permission from their churches. Maria is willing to go to churches and add pamphlets.

CAROLYN GREEN, Chair of Diaper Bank, reported that it is going well. Diapers are delivered 4 times a year to St. James, Birthright – 3 times a year, Catholic Charities —3 times a year, and Genesis —3 times a year. St James is the neediest.

PAM DIULUS suggested a Foster Love Project. The project for the year was voted on and accepted, stuffing 10 diaper bags for infants and 10 duffel bags for toddlers for the Foster Love Project in Wilkinsburg. The bags and items will be bought by CCS and packed on sight at CCS. Dates will be forthcoming for the packing of the bags.

An additional project being considered is going to a tagging day at the Foster Love facility. Information is also forthcoming.

Another project voted on and okayed is fulfilling some of the Bradley Center tags for Christmas time, (like an Angel tree). These tags will need to be fulfilled by December 17th. The Conroy Angel Tree tags will still be fulfilled.

Another project suggested by Maria is the Mother of Mercy Fund. This organization provides scholar-ships to children to attend Catholic schools.

Pam mentioned how Mary's Place may also be a link to projects and getting new members. NCCS has initiated this project.

MARY ANN GONOT has called to be accepted and given a date to have the CCS group for the Charlie Batch Christmas wrapping project, a project we participated in last year.

The Christmas party for CCS is Wednesday, December 3 at Cucina Vitale (formerly Scoglio's) in Greentree, where it was held in the past years. A short general meeting will be held at the CCS Christmas Party.

Other general business meetings have been set for October 15, 2025, at Banksville Eat'n Park, 11:00 and November 15, 2025, at the CCS room, 11:00.

FINANCIAL DONATIONS COMMITTEE

At the Christ Child Society meeting on October 15th at Eat'n Park, the members decided to set up a committee to look at various organizations to which we can send financial donations for the good of children.
